Protecting your workers and family members if you suspect Avian Influenza on your farm - A guide for BC's poultry farmers

- 1. Are my employees aware of the risks of Human AI infection?
 - Have I discussed it with them during their orientation?
 - Worker Orientation Checklist
 - Acknowledgment of Training
- 2. Have I provided appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) to my workers to prevent against infection? e.g.; rubber boots, disposable nitrile gloves and coveralls, N-95 respirators and eye protection
 - If not, please see AgSafe's document RE: PPE Required
- 3. Do my employees know how to appropriately select and use respirators to protect against AI?
 - If not, please contact AgSafe to arrange for respirator fit testing and worker training
 - Dust/Mist Respirators | Dual Cartridge Respirators
 - Care, cleaning & storage of respirator
 - Arrange fit testing and worker training
- 4. Are my employees aware of the current level of AI Virus on my farm which they are being exposed to as they work?
 - If not, please see the AgSafe document which includes risk assessments notification of worker exposure to Al
 - Worker Acknowledgement Form
- 5. Do my employees know how to protect themselves from potential infection whilst completing their chores?
 - If not, please see the AgSafe's safe work procedure about preventing AI exposure and modify to suit your needs
 - Safe Work Procedure
- 6. If one of my poultry employees experiences influenza-like illness at work who should they call for first aid?
 - First Aid notice for on-farm use
